- OH133846 Maria A (Yoder) died 1918 and Nathan Neiswender born 2 Feb., 1857 and died 28 Jan., 1916 at Howerters Church Cemetery
- OH133844 Elmira (Yoder) dau. of George and Judith Klock Yoder 4 Sept., 1856-25 July, 1908 and Daniel M Reiner 19 Nov., 1842 -5 May, 1919
- OH13318 Sebastian Zimmerman's birth and death date and month in addition to year(already indicated) are listed as "2 June", 1830 and "1 July", 1912 in Eden Church Records
- OH1331b727 Walter Alvin Yoder's tombstone is next to his parents with birth and death date of 1921-1940. The 1940 death date is not in your "The descendants of Hans Yoder"
- OH1331bb4 Emma (Beury) Yoder is also buried at Salem United Methodist Church with dates 1883 and 1925. Rev George M Doll was officiating at the funeral.
- OH1338342 Buried at Frieden's Cemetery, Hegins: Clarence V, son of Amos R and Mary A Yoder, born 14 Nov., 1877, died Feb. \_\_, 1878, age 3 months and \_\_ days (tombstone not readable)
- OH13388 Sarah Yoder Baldwin's tombstone verifies year of birth and death and includes "age as 85-2-20"
- OH1338a John B Yoder's tombstone is in Frieden's Cemetery with date of death as 1 Aug., 1905 and age as 65-5-12, which would calculate to birth date of 26 March, 1840.
- OH1338317 Bessie Stahl's tombstone is next to Amos with dates of 1890 and 1923. Amos's date of birth is confirmed as 1889, but I could not read death date, which appears to be 19\_\_.
- OH1338318. Emma is buried beside Amos and Bessie with death date of 1949
- OH133841 David W is buried at Frieden's Cemetery with birth and death dates of

1873 and 1936. His wife is buried next to him with tombstone reading "Charlotte J 1891-1974". Buried with them is Donald D born 1935 and died 1937, probably a son?

OH1331925 "Baby Yoder recorded 18 Dec., 1902, female, died 4 days after birth in Pitman, died 19 Aug, 1902 and buried in Union Cemetery on 21 Aug., 1902, parents Felix and Rebecca Yoder"

OH133831 "Simon R Yoder, 48 years, painter, born in Barry Twp. died Hegins East buried Lutheran and Reformed 22 Sept, 1897" Note- Cemetery would be Friedens as it was the only L&R church in the Hegins Valley

OH1331bb? "Edna Yoder, born Lavelle, died of complications buried Barry Twp March 18, 1897, age 5, dau. of Albert and Saloma Yoder." Note- no Edna is listed in your document.

OH1331b1? "Violet Yoder, born Lavelle, died of complications buried Barry Twp. May 21, 1897, age 2, dau. of Andrew and Maria Yoder" Note- no Violet is listed in your document.

OH13319 "Harris Yoder died at age 73 years 25 days single died in Elonc? Twp East, buried Union Church 27 Nov., 1901" Note- date and place of burial checks, age of 73 years 25 days is 5 days short of 1 year greater than dates listed? "Single" status could be wife dying before him?

OH1331b "Reuben Yoder died at age 83, born Upper Mahantongo was farmer, son of John and Sarah Yoder, died 22 Jan., 1900". Note father listed as John in lieu of Andrew- could have been John Andrew? Would make birth year 1816 if not born in Jan.

Note: I have 8 other Yoder records of death in that same list, which I cannot tie to the descendants of Hans Yoder as follows, I have additional info if interested.
